Father, I pray in the name of Jesus that You would save the leaders of _____. Bring them into a personal relationship with Your Son, Jesus Christ. Move on their hearts to do everything to advance the cause of Christ in _____ (John 3:16; Acts 4:12).

Father, I plead that You will give the leaders of _____ a hunger for You. Cause them to desire You and Your will above all things (Psalm 42:1-2).

Father, I ask that You will blind the unsaved leaders of _____. Do not allow them to gain any understanding about the church, its leaders, or its activities. Hinder them from taking any evil actions against Your people (Jeremiah 32:17).

Father, I pray that the leaders of _____ will be given God-fearing advisors and godly counsel (Proverbs 9:10).

Father, I ask that the leaders of _____ will recognize their own inadequacy and will pray and seek the will of God for their lives and their decisions (Proverbs 3:5-8).

Father, I plead that the leaders of _____ will be generous and have compassionate hearts for the poor and the needy (Psalm 112:9; Luke 10:33-37).

Father, I pray that the leaders of _____ will desire honesty, integrity, and loyalty (Psalm 26; Proverbs 11:3).

Father, I ask that the leaders of _____ will be prepared to give an account to You, the Almighty God who has placed them in their positions (Hebrews 9:27).

Father, I pray that the leaders of _____ will desire humility and meekness and be willing to serve and cooperate with others (John 13:14; Titus 3:1-2).

Father, I plead that the leaders of _____ will endeavor to restore the sanctity of life, families, divine order, and morality in _____ (Ephesians 5:22-6:4).

Father, I ask that You would grant the leaders of _____ wisdom and knowledge for their task of leadership (James 1:5).

Father, I pray that the leaders of _____ will be convicted of their sins and will confess and repent of those sins (Proverbs 28:13, 1 John 1:9; James 4:8).
