Praying About Your Wife's Trust

Your wife's trust is a fragile gift. You must strive to be the kind of man that she can trust. Moreover, you have to cover this area in prayer. If you feel that your wife does not trust you, it's not so much that she *doesn't* want to trust you. It's just that she *can't* trust you.

Perhaps her dad or a boyfriend did or didn't do something that causes her to be hesitant in trusting. Perhaps frightening things happened in her past. It might be that her relationship to God is not intimate and she hasn't learned the safety and security of trusting Him. Your wife may have had experiences that make it difficult for her to trust you. There is hope though.

Through your praying, she can be healed and she can learn to trust you. The following Scripture prayers can help you pray about this vital area. You might consider praying one day on a regular basis.

Father, Your Word declares that the heart of the virtuous woman's husband

Father, cause _______ to see Your work in my life. I ask that she would trust that You are working in my life. O God, change me and reveal these changes to ______ (Philippians 2:12-13).

I pray that _____ would trust in You and would rely on You in all the circumstances of her life. Father, in every circumstances of her life, deliver her from fear and anxiety. Even

when she is walking in darkness, cause her to know that You are there and that You will not forsake her (**Isaiah 50:10**).

Father, I ask that _____ would put her confidence in You. Set her free from ever placing more confidence in people than in You. Teach her to trust You above all others (**Psalm 118:8**).

Father, I ask that _____ would put her trust in You. Cause her to know that You are her Rock and Fortress and her Deliverer. Teach her that You are the God of her strength (2 Samuel 22:2).

Praying For Your Child's Relationship To God's Word

A love for the Word of God can begin at an early age. This love is crucial for your child's life. The Word of God can provide direction and offer guidance to your child. It can reveal God and His will to your child. As your child grows in his or her love for the Word of God, he or she will turn to it and seek its truths. This is sowing a spiritual habit that will bless and direct him or her all the days of his or her life.

The following prayers can help you pray for your child to have a love for God's Word. You can use these or develop your own from them. In order to use the prayers, place your child's name in the blank and plead the truth of the Scripture in his or her behalf.

Let the roots of Your Word grow deep into his/her heart and mind so that he/she can preserve and endure the testing of his/her faith (Luke 8:11-13).

The Model Prayer And Missions (Matthew 6:9-13)

The Model Prayer provides the believer with an outline of prayer. It also offers an outline for intercession. You can use the Model Prayer to plead for God's work of grace in a nation or among a people group. The following prayer guide uses the Model Prayer as a way to plead for the salvation of people. In order to use the prayer guide place the name of the nation or people group in the blank.
