Praying About Your Wife's Relationships

Your wife needs godly, healthy relationships. She needs and deserves quality friends who will love her, encourage her, and minister to her. She needs friends who will build her up. She needs faithful friends who will listen to her and pray for her. She needs friends who will help her grow as a Christian, a woman, a wife, and a mother.

At the same time, she needs good, relationships with healthy family members. Relationships with in-laws especially delicate. These are relationships can sometimes be complex and frustrating. You can't assume that your wife's relationship to your family is going to be good. You fell in love your wife; this with does not automatically guarantee that your family will fall in love with her. You must cover these relationships with prayer.

The following Scripture prayers can help you cover your wife's relationships: Father, I ask that You would grant _______friends who will love her at all times. I plead that You would empower these friends to help her face adversity (**Proverbs 17:17**).

Father, provide ______ with friends who will pray fervently for her. Surround her with friends who will be devoted and diligent in prayer for her, giving thanks continually for her friendship (**Colossians 4:2**).

Father, I pray that would choose her friends carefully. Give her a discerning heart. Deliver her from friends who might lead her astray from You and obedience to Your Word (**Proverbs 12:26**).

Righteous God, I plead that would show herself friendly to others. Empower her to be an authentic friend to others. Grant her friends who will share deep bonds of love and commitment with her (**Proverbs 18:24**).

Father, fill _____'s life with loving friends who will tell her what she needs to hear. Enable them to speak those things that will help her become stronger (**Ephesians 4:29**).

Deliver ______ from any attitudes or actions that would hinder or destroy her relationships. I ask that she would be kind and loving to others, forgiving them as God for Christ's sake has forgiven her (**Colossians 4:31-32**).

Lord God, raise up friends for ______ that will give her wise counsel and sound advice. I plead that she will have the wisdom and humility to receive these things (**Proverbs 10:13**).

Father, show me the truth about my family's relationship to ______. Fill me with the humility that I need to receive this. Empower me to do whatever it takes to improve and deepen this relationship. Grant me the wisdom and sensitivity to do this (**Psalm 139:23-24**).

Father, I ask that You would grant favor and influence with You and my family (Luke 2:52). I pray that my family would see ______as a gift from You. Cause them to realize that she is a blessing, a valuable asset, a unique person (**John 3:27**).

Father, I plead that my family would have a deep and abiding love for ______. Empower them to minister to her and to encourage her (1 John 4:7).

Father, I ask that You will grant to us other couples with which we can develop deep and abiding relationships. I plead that You would raise up friends that we can love and that will love us, that we can encourage and that can encourage us, that we can help to grow and that can help us to grow (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10).

Father, I pray that ______ would develop a servant's heart concerning my family. Help her to say and do those things that will improve and strengthen her relationship with my family (**Matthew 20:28**).

Lesson 6: The Power Of Purity

Central Truth: Pursuing sexual purity will enable you to pray powerfully and effectively for your wife.

God's desire for you is sexual purity, "For this is the will of God, your sanctification; that you should abstain for sexual immorality" (**1 Thessalonians 4:3**). This desire extends to every area of your life—your thinking, your words, and your actions. This is God's will for your life.

Read and Meditate On The Word

The following verses speak to God's desire for sexual purity. Read the verses and meditate on how they apply to your relationship to your wife.

Exodus 20:14

Matthew 5:27-30

Proverbs 5:15-23

1 Corinthians 7:1-5

These verses reveal that you are to pursue sexual purity in every area of your life. It is God's desire for you. It safeguards and enriches your marriage. And, it enables you to pray in power for your wife. If you are wrapped up in lust, physical or emotional adultery, you will not be able to seek God intensely for your wife. Pursuing sexual purity helps you make prayer a priority by helping you focus on the wife that God has given you.

Listening And Talking With Your Father

Ask your Father to reveal to you any areas where you have allowed sexual

sin to gain ground. It may be in your thought life, your feelings, your words,

or your actions. Plead with Him to reveal any relationships that might be a problem for you. Record the insights that He gives you in this area.

Pray that He would enable you to take back any ground that you have given to sexual impurity. Ask Him to grant you the grace and power to pursue sexual purity with all you being.

Praying For Your Relationship

One of the best safeguards to sexual impurity is to find delight and joy in your wife. Pray that the two of you will experience deeper and richer intimacy in your marriage. Claim **Proverbs 5:18** for your marriage, "Let your wife be a fountain of blessing for you. Rejoice in the wife of your youth" (NLT).

Praying For Your Child: Godly Relationships And Influences

Father, I plead that ______ will resist temptation when he/she is enticed by friends and acquaintances. Empower him/her to refuse their invitations to rebellion. Deliver him/her from yielding to ungodly friends and role models. Keep ______ from following in their path (**Proverbs 1:10**, **15**).

Father, enable ________to stay away from foolish people. Let him/her develop deep and abiding relationships with those who know You, who seek You, and who love You and Your Word (**Proverbs 14:7**).

would detest the sin of the ungodly. Grant him/her a hatred of rebellion against You and Your Word. I ask in the name of Jesus Christ that You would grant him/her strength when he/she is ridiculed or tempted by them. Pour out Your power, mercy, and love on him/her during these times. Help _______ to stand strong in the faith, not wavering or doubting. Do not allow the ridicule and opposition of ungodly people to silence or discourage him/her (**Proverbs 29:27**).

will rest in You and wait patiently for You to act. Deliver him/her from envying the wicked and believing that the path of obedience is foolish and senseless. Cause him/her to know that the path of obedience and surrender to You is the only way to true life, joy, security, and hope (**Psalm 37:7**).

Protect him/her from the devil's lie that the path of selfishness and pride is the way to life and joy. Let him/her understand clearly the consequences of following those who refuse You and Your Word (**Psalm 73:27**).
