Intercessory Repentance

The God of the Bible is a holy God. He His is opposed to evil. hates sin. Because of this, people must repent. Repent means to turn away from. It is hating sin and striving to forsake sin. If we are going to be in a right relationship with God, we must repent of sin. We must be willing to deal with the evil in our personal lives. We cannot expect God work bless or if we are compromising with sin.

What do the following verses teach you about repentance?

1 John 1:9

Luke 13:1-3

Acts 17:30

These verses teach the utter necessity of turning from sin. They reveal that repentance is something that both the unbeliever and the believer must do. Repentance is to characterize the lifestyle of the child of God.

One of the tools that you can use in prayerwalking is intercessory

repentance. This means that you confess the sins of others and ask God to have mercy on them and to grant them repentance. Your confession of sin does not mean that they are forgiven and the sin is dealt with. But, it is a way of pleading for God to have mercy on a person, a church, a city, or an area.

In your text for the day, the high priest went in to the Holy of holies on the Day of Atonement. He did this in order to confess the sins of the people and to ask God to have mercy on them (Leviticus 16:15-16). This is a model for your prayerwalking. Intercessory repentance is confessing the sins of others in order to plead with God to have mercy on them. It is calling on God to grant them repentance that they might turn to Him and come clean with Him.

Pray that God will reveal your sin to you and enable you to confess and repent of your sin. Call on Him to help you see the sin around you that you might confess it and plead with Him for mercy. Ask Him to create a clean heart and a right spirit in you.

Covering The Churches

One of the great blessings of the Christian life is your brothers and sisters in Christ. God has made you a part of His family. Yet, you must realize that the family of God is bigger than your church. Your brothers and sisters in

Christ exist in all the churches around you. They may have a different name. They may worship in a different way. They may have different convictions concerning the non-essentials of the faith. But they are your brothers and sisters in Christ.

What does Jesus pray for all believers in **John 17:20-22**?

Jesus prays that all believers would experience unity and that this unity would bring others to believe in Jesus.

You may be wondering how this applies to prayerwalking. One of the best ways to prayerwalk is to cover the churches in your area. It is to pray on site at the churches in your area. These are your brothers and sisters in Christ. They need your prayers. Prayerwalking other churches is a way of fulfilling **John 17:20-22**.

You may be wondering, "How can I pray for other churches?" You might consider the following:

Pray for the pastor and staff of the church.

- Pray that they would lead people to Jesus and disciple them.
- ❖ Ask that God would supply them all they need to do His will.
- Plead that God would enable them to deal with the problems they may have.
- Pray that they will experience the power of God.
- ❖ Ask that they will grow in unity.

These are only some requests that you might consider as you cover the churches in your area. As you pray on site, the Holy Spirit will guide you in what to pray.

What is your attitude toward the other churches in your area? Do you see them as enemies, competitors, or friends? Ask God to search your heart concerning this. Pray that you will see them as your brothers and sisters in Christ and that God will grant you a fresh love for them. Pray that God will create within you a clean heart and a right spirit.
